The Multi-Flow Map is used for identifying the causes and effects of an event.



Constructing a Multi-Flow Map

The Multi-Flow Map is used by students for illustrating and analyzing cause and effect relationships. In the center rectangle, write an important event that occurred. On the left side of the event, write the causes of that event. On the right side of the event, write the effects of that event. Add arrows pointing to the right to show how the causes lead INTO the event and how the effects come OUT of the event.
