

Lesson Plan

Name of Lesson: Castle Shutter Book.

Objective: Combine all of your knowledge about the fall of the Roman Empire and the Feudalism Age into a shutter book report.

Content Standard: Fall of Rome & European Feudalism.

Review: You will be putting together all of the various activities that we have covered over the past several weeks into a single collection of work. The Castle Shutter book will examine the various themes we have discussed concerning the fall of the Roman Empire and Feudalism in Europe during the Middle Ages. The following criteria will be used to help you prepare your book and organize your information.

Directions:

1. Put together your shutter book. Your teacher will demonstrate what to do. Follow directions.
2. Place on the inside center the final draft of your "I Am" poem.
3. Now pay attention to the RIGHT SIDE of your shutter book.
4. Place on the right side a tri-fold paper for your Roman Empire map. Title the outside of the tri-fold "The Fall of the Roman Empire."
5. On the inside top fold write a short summary about the "Empire in Prosperity." Include a picture on the cover of the fold.
6. On the inside bottom fold write a short summary about the "Empire in Transition."
7. Place your final map of the Roman Empire on the remaining flap.
8. Now pay attention to the Left side of your project.
9. Place on the left side a tri-fold paper for your map of the manor lands. Label the outside of the tri-fold "Europe after the fall of the Roman Empire."
10. On the inside top fold write a short summary about "Charlemagne's Empire." Include a picture on the cover of the fold.
11. On the inside bottom fold write a short summary about "Life in the Town." Include a picture on the cover of the fold.
12. Place your final map of the manor lands on the remaining flap.
